Adult Formation Opportunities starting in the Fall Disciple – 2010/2011

Disciple is a year long process of studying the bible. For over 30 weeks you will gather with a small group of other Christians to be nourished by God's Word, by prayer and by the Christian fellowship of those in your group. The Disciple groups will be starting in early September.

Disciple I - *Becoming Disciples Through Bible Study* – led by Bobby Horn & David Turner on Sunday evenings starting September 12 from 4:00 to 6:30 while the children are in Mission Maniacs and the youth in Youth Fellowship. This class will be a 34 week general survey of the entire Bible.

Disciple II - *Into the Word Into the World* – led by Sandra Miks on Mondays starting September 13 at 6:30.. The books of Genesis, Exodus, Luke, and Acts are each studied for eight weeks.

Disciple III - *Remember Who You Are* - led Jeannie & Johnny Walker on Mondays at 6:30 starting August 30. The books of the prophets are studied in the first 16 weeks and Paul's letters in the second 16 weeks.

Disciple IV - *Under The Tree Of Life* – led by Bill Fontenot & Terry Bukowski on Thursday evenings at 6:30 starting September 9. This is an intensive 32-week study of Old and New Testament Writings.

2nd Saturday Women's Bible Study



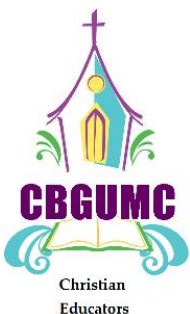

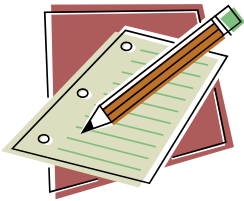

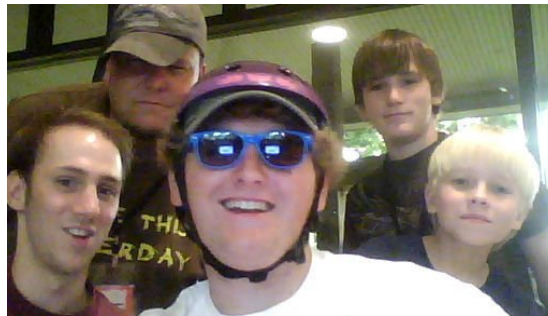


Confirmation Classes

From The Organist

WHY DID THE ORGANIST DO THAT?!!!

Grace and peace to you, my CBG family. So what exactly is with all the Bach I'm playing for preludes? Again, the simple answer is that I'm Lutheran, and I was lucky enough to hear Bach every Sunday while I was growing up. So, even if I were to play a French Romantic organ (like First Presbyterian, Houston has) or an American Orchestral organ (like St. Martin's Episcopal, Houston has), I'd still be playing a lot of Bach. But, we have a "Bach Organ". It would be a crime in the organ community not to utilize the instrument for its intended purpose.

What is a "Bach Organ" and why is it so special? Well, first and foremost, it's a tracker instrument. When I press a key, I'm physically opening a valve that lets air into a pipe, rather than having an electrical current do the work. That makes the touch stiffer and makes the connection between musician and sound more intimate. Organ purists much prefer to play tracker instruments. What also separates our instrument from other organs is the manual compass (the number of keys on each keyboard). The compass of our organ is shorter than that of modern instruments by half of an octave. Not a big deal if you're playing Bach, but there aren't enough notes to play say Messiaen. (Messiaen colored way outside the lines!) The third most distinguishing feature is that there are no combination pistons in historic instruments. Organists had helpers who turned pages for them, pumped air into the chambers, and changed stops for them. Janet and I are lucky in that we have five combinations we can use. So, we're not completely roughing it.

Back in the early 1990's, the Bach Society, which meets at Christ the King Lutheran Church in Houston (huge church, lots and lots of money), decided to build an organ similar to what Bach would have played. Guess what? With the exception of a few minor changes, they built the same organ we have at Ferry Road! And yes, our organ's almost as big. Christ the King has 35 ranks (a set of pipes per sound); we have 33. We were 20 years ahead of our time back when we built this organ. I look forward to our leading the way in worship now.

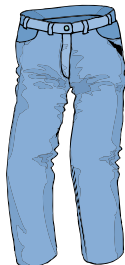
