It's exciting times around here. We had a wonderful VBS – top attendance of 213 children with an additional 79 youth and adult workers. We indeed are shaking things up around here for the Lord! Many thanks to Lori Tadlock, VBS coordinator and all who helped make VBS 2011 a big success.

Celebration Singers is off on tour Friday, June 24 through Saturday, July 2. This year the tour's theme is "Increasing Christ's Footprint" and focuses on our church's mission statement. The youth choir will sing 6 performances while on the road, visit the Heifer Project International Learning Center near Little Rock and both UMC affiliated Vanderbilt University and the Upper Room museum in Nashville Tennessee. July will also include UMARMY and Summit. Both of these are youth mission trips. In early August we'll have an upper elementary mission week called AIM (Adventures In Methodism). Our children do a great job serving. Many thanks to them and their leaders for their hard work. We still need prayer partners to write letters to the students and leaders. Also, in July we'll be worshipping on Sunday evening with other UM churches in Baytown in a series called Faith for Living. 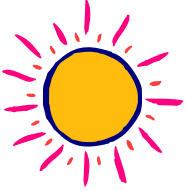
